The 2023 [Gender Social Norms Index](#) (GSNI) is a report prepared by the United Nation’s Human Development Reports Office (UNDP).

The purpose of the GSNI is to quantify negative biases against women. The GSNI estimates the percentage of people across 91 nations that hold one bias across one of four dimensions: political, educational, economic, and physical integrity. *(The GSNI2 indicates the percentage of people holding at least 2 biases. The World Cup and Global ranking is based on the GNSI.)*
