GDP measures the monetary value (in USD currency) of final goods and services—that is, those that are bought by the final user—produced in a country in a given period of time (usually a year). It counts all of the output generated within the borders of a country. It can be presented as an overall value, or per capita.

The data presented is based on 2022 [World Bank](#) calculations. Overall GDP is used in the World Cup and Global rankings.

Note: England totals are from the United Kingdom which also includes independent FIFA members Northern Ireland, Scotland, and Wales in the calculation.
