The [Gross National Income Per Capita](#) (GNI-PC) measure from the World Bank attempts to reflect the average citizen's income (before taxes). 2021 Data is presented in USD currency and is intended to reflect the current standard of living within each country.

In the 2021 table, Singapore had the highest GNI-PC for women (\$75,094 USD) with Luxembourg finishing second (70,117 USD) - Yemen finished last (\$176 USD) of 178 nations.

Note: England scores use United Kingdom data (includes independent FIFA members Northern Ireland, Scotland, and Wales) in the calculation.
